At the same time, our colleagues from SIGA-FSIA will be offering exciting workshops and lectures for experts in the field of anesthesia care and holding their annual general meeting.

In the evening, the SSAPM Congress Party will take place at the Musée Olympique – food, drinks, and great beats from DJ QUBE! Don't miss out!

Following the great success of last year's inaugural Swiss Anaesthesia Trainees' Day (SAT-Day), an initiative led by our younger colleagues, this year's program includes POCUS and simulation workshops, and exam preparation in small groups, designed to maximize learning impact. Experienced colleagues are, of course, warmly welcome to join these sessions. In addition to the SAT-Day, an EEG workshop will be offered. A strong turnout on Saturday will once again enhance the interactive and educational atmosphere of the congress.

EEG for Anaesthesiologists – A workshop**Background:**

Anaesthesiologists are expected to integrate widely available EEG-neuromonitoring devices as part of individualised anaesthesia care for an increasingly ageing and vulnerable population. Yet, training and practice opportunities for this technique are limited and therefore self-reported confidence in effectively integrating these devices for critical decision-making remains low.

Our workshop is tailored to the individual provider's needs and aims to address this education gap. This is a refined version of previous workshops, integrating participants' evaluations.

Structure of workshop:

The workshop is designed as a blended learning module (60 minutes of prior self-study, in-person workshop at the conference). The workshop contains 3x 90 minutes modules spaced out over 6h, including short input talks and interactive elements as well as workshop stations for hands-on small group work. Refreshment breaks (2x 30 minutes) will also serve as an opportunity to connect to other participants and the facilitators in person.
